Focus on viewsheds from key tourist routes, key tourist/recreational areas and lookouts, along with identifying highly valued landforms. Consider what planning and design implications this will mean for land included in a Landscape Values Special Control Area in LPS4.

Review technical investigations and update accordingly.

Undertake other work identified through the gap analysis.

Undertake research and analysis.

Site inspections with Working Group.

Review and update LPS report. Prepare revised Strategy Plans and associated supporting plans.

Seek Working Group support.

Seek Council support to publicly release the draft LPS for community/stakehold er comment.

Request the WAPC to certify the draft LPS and authorise that it can be publicly advertised.
