**ROAD & RESERVE NAMING WITHIN THE SHIRE****Objective**

To enable Council to prioritise and determine the allocation of road names to roads that are new or require a new name or named for the first time.

Nothing in this policy shall prevent Council from determining the recommendation to the Geographic Naming Committee of an alternative name for a road if Council believes the alternative name selected is more appropriate.

Names that refer to current or former families within the Shire of Denmark should generally only be allocated to streets or roads within the locality that the family ordinarily resides or resided.

On behalf of the descendants of the Bayley family, I am writing to request that the creek - currently I understand, unnamed - be officially named Bayley Creek.

The creek rises on dot 374, the result of seepage from the hills above it, & flows out of the lot, under Scotsdale Road & into the Denmark River.

Lot 374 was owned by the Bayley family for 75 years, & housed a member of the family for over 40 years until its sale in 2001.

Water into the creek was channeled by underground box drains & dammed. Water from the dam was pumped - originally by an hydrolic ram, & latterly by electric pump - to a tank on the hill, from whence it gravitated to watering points. The water was used for watering cattle & sheep, for irrigating potato crops & small vegetable gardens, & to water the original grape cuttings for Howard Park winery.

vineyard. Under new ownership of Lot 374, water is still being used for stock water, & the flow in the creek seldom varies.

For all these historic reasons, this request is made for the creek be named Bayley Creek.
